FFP Dress Code

How we present ourselves affects the sincerity of the message we proclaim. Therefore, all of our decisions regarding dress should focus on respect, modesty and sensitivity for the churches we partner with and for the communities in which we are working.

When out in the community (outside our lodging place):

1. Shorts, skirts and dresses should be no higher than 3 inches above the knee.
2. No sleeveless shirts including spaghetti straps, halters and tank tops are permitted.
3. Do not wear clothing that will exposure the abdomen or is skintight.
4. Do not wear clothing with logos, labels, wording or other designs that may be considered inappropriate or inconsistent with our mission.

When in the church for worship and/or VBS:

1. Men wear long pants and short sleeved shirts.
2. Women wear skirts and blouses with sleeves over the shoulder or dresses with short sleeves.
3. Sandals without socks are acceptable, but please beware of injuring toes walking in the dark.
4. Jewelry and make-up must be kept at a minimum to show respect for the culture of the Pentecostal church.
5. Tattoos should be covered with clothing or make-up.
6. Piercings in places other than ears should be taken out or very small jewelry worn.
7. Avoid chewing gum in church services.
8. Water bottles and cameras are allowed in worship services.
