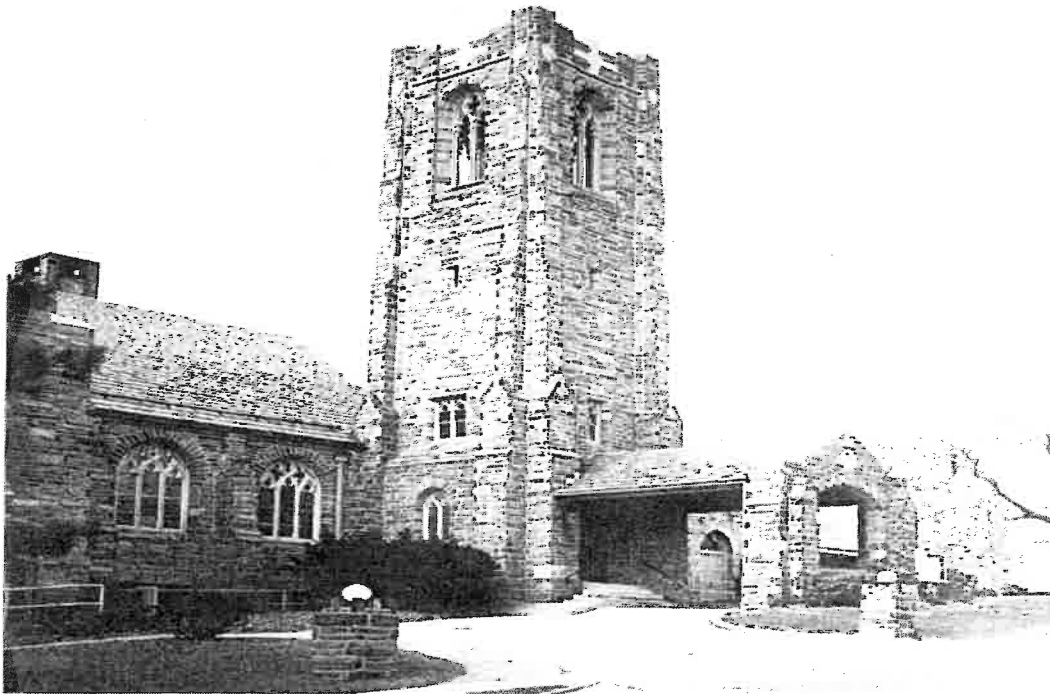


## ***Prayer for Use Before Worship***
